The St. Rose CYO Travel Basketball Program is a competitive travel basketball program that abides by the rules and guidelines set forth by *CYO of Long Island (CYOLI)*, in conjunction with St. Rose CYO policies.

Below is a brief overview of the **TBB 4-8 Guidelines**. A detailed version of this document can be found on the St. Rose CYO website under Travel Basketball > Sport Information.

- Fees: Grades 4 thru 7 - \$340 per player – fee includes practices, participation in the CYOLI Travel League and a player uniform.
- Fees: Grade 8 - \$360 per player – fee includes practices, participation in the CYOLI Travel League, player uniform, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade awards event (for player only).
- Late registration and walk-ins on the day of tryout is not permitted.
- Each grade will have two (2) tryout sessions. **Player must attend one (1) FULL\* tryout session to be considered for a travel team. \* Late arrival and/or early departure from the tryout session is NOT considered a FULL tryout.** It is highly recommended that players attend both tryout sessions to ensure adequate time for proper evaluation.
- Player must play at their grade level.
- Player must play on the team for which they are selected and cannot request specific team placement. Once a player is ROSTERED, they cannot opt out of playing for that team. If a player chooses to opt out, the player cannot participate in any St. Rose CYO program for the current year and is not eligible to try out for Travel Basketball the following season.
- Evaluators and coaches will be selecting the team.
- Teams will consist of a minimum of 10 players and a maximum of 12 players.
- Grade levels will consist of a maximum of 2 teams.
- Season: Girls → September thru February Boys → mid- September thru March
- Team selection notification done within approximately 48-72 hours upon completion of the final try out date for each grade level. Player will be notified via email if they *have* or *have not* been selected to a Travel Team.
- Uniform fitting will occur shortly after the team selection process has been completed.
- Travel fee payment is required in full for a player to be allowed to participate in practices/games.
- Head coach will have a pre-season meeting to review playing time and team rules.
